



Future Potential Guide or Staff Member,

We are excited that you are interested in serving at Royal Family Kids' Camp of Lenexa! This is our 18th year in a row, to serve local children, ages 6-11 that have a history of abuse and neglect. This year, our one-week, overnight camp will be held June 9-14, 2019.

Our **all-volunteer** staff have many different talents and gifts but we all share one thing in common. We each have a heart to share God's love with hurting children. We offer several ways to get involved during camp.

Each position requires a background check, interview and training. Below is a brief description for each position.

Guides - Must be at least 18 years old and at camp 24 hours a day throughout the week. Requires lots of patience and the ability to put the camper's needs above their own. Each guide is assigned only 2 campers and also teamed up with a veteran "Buddy Guide" that also has 2 campers. Together, they navigate all the fun of camp! Two breaks per day are provided. Guides sleep in the same cabin as their campers.

Staff - Must be at least 18 years old and may choose from a day shift or stay at camp 24/7. Must be patient, hardworking and flexible. Each staff person is responsible for helping camp run smoothly and providing support to the guides. Staff helps with swimming, activity centers, music, drama and so much more. Staff members get to know lots of the campers throughout the week. Staff sleep in cabins or dorm type rooms.

Dorm Relief - Must be at least 18 years old and available Monday-Thursday from 7-11 pm. Tag along for the evening special event and once the campers are tucked in for the night, Dorm Relief quietly sit in the cabins and provide a safe environment while the guides take an evening break.

Teen Assistant - Very limited positions available. Must be responsible and have excellent references. Teens assist the staff, not the campers directly. Age 16+ may apply.

Mandatory Training for ALL New Guides, Staff, Teens and Dorm Relief:

We will handout training manuals and give an overview of camp. Further required self-paced training will also be handed out and due by May 4th.

Before you apply, we ask that you prayerfully consider the magnitude of this commitment. We can only accept campers based on how many Guides and staff members have committed to the week.
